AN ACT Authorizing the Payment of an Annuity by the City of  
Portland to Nettie M. Hamilton.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The city council of the City of Portland may annually hereafter appropriate and pay to Nettie M. Hamilton, widow of Osborne L. Hamilton, a former member of the police department of said city, who died on the seventh day of October, 1920, by reason of injuries received while in the discharge of his official duties, a sum not exceeding three hundred dollars for the benefit of herself and her minor children. Said annuity may be granted to the said Nettie M. Hamilton during her widowhood. And in case of the

10 death or marriage of the said Nettie M. Hamilton before said  
11 minor children shall arrive at the age of twenty-one years,  
12 then said annuity may be paid to the guardian of said minor  
13 children.
