**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Amend Section Fifty-seven of Chapter Eight of the Revised Statutes Relating to the Duties of the Forest Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That section fifty-seven of chapter eight of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:
3 'He may also establish within the state one or more forest
4 nurseries, the maintenance of which shall be paid from the
5 appropriation for that purpose, the object of which is de-
6 clared to be, to furnish forest tree seedlings and transplants
7 at cost of production for use in planting the waste and cut-
8 over lands of the state,' so that said section as amended
9 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 57. He shall prepare tracts or circulars of information, giving plain and concise advice for the care of wood-lands and for the preservation of forest growth. These publications shall be furnished to any citizen of the state upon application. He may also establish within the state one or more forest nurseries, the maintenance of which shall be paid from the appropriation for that purpose, the object of which is declared to be, to furnish forest tree seedlings and transplants at cost of production for use in planting the waste and cut-over lands of the state.'
