STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Repeal the Law Requiring an Annual Appropriation of the Sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars for State Aid Construction.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:Section 1. Section thirty-four of chapter twenty-five of2 the revised statutes is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect only upon the adoption 2 in September, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, of the pro-3 posed amendment to section seventeen of article nine of 4 the constitution, permitting the use of the proceeds of state 5 highway bonds for the construction of state aid highways; 6 and in case of such adoption shall take effect on the date 7 said constitutional amendment becomes effective.
