STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for the Improvement of the Maine State Prison at Thomaston.

Resolved: That the sum of seventy thousand dollars be, 2 and hereby is, appropriated for the improvement of the 3 state prison at Thomaston, by the construction of a new 4 cell block, the same to be expended by the board of prison 5 commissioners, subject to the approval of the governor and 6 council. Said appropriation to be available in the fiscal year 7 beginning July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve is in accordance with the amounts recommended by the committee on budget for the maintenance of the state prison for the period named in the resolve.
