# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT Amending Section Thirty-three of Chapter Eightyeight of the Revised Statutes, Relating to the Giving of Counsel by a Municipal or Police Judge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-three of chapter eighty-eight of the revised

2 statutes is hereby amended so that the same shall read as

3 follows:

'Sect. 33. No judge of any municipal or police court shall 2 act as counsel or attorney in any case, cause, matter or

- 3 thing, which depends upon or relates to any cause exclu-
- 4 sively cognizable by the court over which he presides, or
- 5 which is actually brought in said court, although concur-
- 6 rently cognizable by some other court.'
