STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Maine State Prison for Maintenance and Current Expenses.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for

- 2 the Maine state prison, for the fiscal period January first,
- 3 nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June thirtieth, nine-
- 4 teen hundred and twenty-one, inclusive, the sum of forty-
- 5 four thousand nine hundred dollars, for the purposes here-
- 6 inafter specified, namely:

Personal services of officers and employees, twentyfive thousand dollars, \$25,000 oo

Maintenance, including food supplies, clothing, repairs on buildings and general expenses, eighteen thousand dollars,

Retiring and pensioning prison officials, one thousand nine hundred dollars, 1,900 00

And be it further resolved that there be, and hereby is, 2 appropriated for said Maine state prison for the fiscal year 3 July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June thir-4 tieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, inclusive, the fur-5 ther sum of eighty-nine thousand eight hundred dollars for 6 the same purposes as hereinbefore specified, divided as fol-7 lows, namely:

Personal services of officers and employees, fifty thousand dollars, \$50,000 oo

Maintenance, including food supplies, clothing, repairs on buildings and general expenses, thirty-six thousand dollars, 36,000 oo

Retiring and pensioning prison officials, three thousand eight hundred dollars, 3,800 00

And be it further resolved that there be, and hereby is, 2 appropriated for Maine state prison for the fiscal year July 3 first, nineteen hundred twenty-two, to June thirtieth, nine-4 teen hundred twenty-three, inclusive, the further sum of 5 eighty-nine thousand eight hundred dollars for the same 6 purposes as hereinbefore specified, divided as follows, name-7 ly:

Personal services of officers and employees, fifty thousand dollars, \$50,000 oo

Maintenance, including food supplies, clothing, repairs on buildings and general expenses, thirtysix thousand dollars,

36,000 oo

Retiring and pensioning prison officials, three thou-

sand eight hundred dollars,

3,800 00

Provided, that any balances of the foregoing appropria-2 tions which remain unexpended at the end of the first fiscal 3 period herein specified shall be available for expenditure 4 during the second fiscal period, and any balances remain-5 ing unexpended at the end of the second fiscal period shall 6 be available for expenditure during the third fiscal period 7 hereinbefore specified.

Whereas, the appropriations called for in this resolve, 2 applying to the first fiscal period named herein, are imme-3 diately necessary for the preservation of the public health 4 and safety, and in the opinion of the legislature constitute 5 an emergency as contemplated by the constitution, this re-6 solve shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve is in concurrence with the amounts recommended by the committee on budget for the maintenance of the state prison for the periods named in the resolve.
