STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Adjutant General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section twenty-six of chapter one hundred and seventeen 2 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out 3 all of said section and inserting in place thereof the fol-4 lowing:

'Sect. 26. The adjutant general shall receive an annual 2 salary of twenty-five hundred dollars; he shall receive no 3 other fee, emolument or perquisite.'
