#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Life Insurance for Minors and the Surrender of Such Insurance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Insurance heretofore or hereafter issued upon the life of
2 any person between the ages of fifteen and twenty-one years,
3 for the benefit of such minor, or for the benefit of the father,
4 mother, husband, wife, child, brother or sister of such
5 minor, the insured shall not, by reason only of such minor6 ity, be incompetent to contract for such insurance, or for
7 the surrender of such insurance, or to give a valid dis8 charge for any benefit accruing, or for money payable under
9 the contract, provided that such surrender or discharge shall
10 be given with the consent of the beneficiary.
