STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of R. Lyle Hodgins for Damages Sustained in Building the State Hospital at Bangor.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated 2 the sum of one thousand and fifty-six dollars in favor of 3 R. Lyle Hodgins for damages sustained in building the State 4 hospital at Bangor.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On the seventeenth of November, nineteen hundred and nineteen, Mr. Hodgins submitted a bid for alterations and additions to the State hospital at Bangor. On the twenty-seventh of November he was granted the contract had too many details in the different state departments. The contract was not actually signed and delivered until the latter of February, nineteen hundred and twenty. During the delay caused by the lateness of the signing the prices of material, especially flooring, advanced tremendously and Mr. Hodgins respectfully requests that he be paid one thousand and fifty-six dollars for damages caused him by delay in signing the contract.
