Resolved: That there be and there hereby is appropriated
2 the sum of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) to be paid C. H.
3 Thompson of Calais as compensation for the board and
4 lodging of Mary Socktoma, a member of the Passama-
5 quoddy Tribe of Indians, and of the mother and daughter
6 of Mary Socktoma, while they were nursing the patient.
