RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for Lighting the Narrows
between Lower and Upper Richardson Lakes.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twen-
3 ty-one and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred twen-
4 ty-two, for the purpose of lighting the narrows between
5 Lower and Upper Richardson Lakes.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This appropriation is asked for the purpose of supporting and maintaining lights during the steamboat season along the narrows from Lower to Upper Richardson Lakes, and covers the actual cash outlay by the steamboat men for said purpose, and is necessary for the safety of the travelling public.
