## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Aid of Navigation on Schoodic Grand Lake, Washington County.

Resolved: That the sum of two hundred dollars be, and

- 2 hereby is, appropriated for purchasing buoys to be placed
- 3 and maintained in Schoodic Grand Lake in Washington
- 4 county, said buoys to be placed at such points in said lake
- 5 as will best serve the needs of navigation thereon. Such
- 6 amount of appropriation as is necessary for the purchase
- 7 of not more than four such buoys shall be expended under
- 8 the direction of the state steamboat inspector.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Schoodic Grand Lake is a highway connecting the towns of Orient, Weston and Forest City, in said Washington county, and is used as a highway by inhabitants of this state and others on the shores of North Lake and Grand Lake. The occupants of more than thirty cottages, in addition to the inhabitants of Forest City, will be aided by the placing of these buoys over dangerous reefs in the roadstead. The buoys, if furnished by the state, will be transported from Houlton and set, without expense to the state, by responsible parties, interested in the safety of such navigation, and will probably be placed on stations numbers 2136 to 2139 inclusive of U. S. Coast and Geodetic Survey of 1892.
