**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

RESOLVE, to Aid Navigation on Moosehead Lake.

Whereas the fiscal year of the state of Maine now ends on June thirtieth instead of January first and no money is available under a regular appropriation for the first six months of the year nineteen hundred and twenty-one, and whereas the appropriation for the first six months in nineteen hundred and twenty-one for aiding the navigation on Moosehead Lake is an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety therefore

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated three
2 hundred dollars for the fiscal year nineteen hundred and
3 twenty-one, six hundred dollars for the fiscal year nineteen
4 hundred and twenty-two and seven hundred dollars for the

5 fiscal year nineteen hundred and twenty-three for the plac-
6 ing of buoys in Moosehead Lake, and erection of lights in
7 Moosehead Lake and maintenance of the same, and said
8 buoys and lights shall be erected as will best serve the needs
9 of navigation thereon. All said moneys shall be expended
10 under the supervision of the state steamboat inspectors and
11 said inspectors shall be paid the same as provided in section
12 sixteen of chapter fifty-nine of the revised statutes. If
13 money hereby appropriated is not spent in the year specified
14 it shall be available for the next year.

In view of the emergency cited, this act shall take effect
2 when approved.
