**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT Governing the Conduct of Maternity Hospitals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The powers, duties and responsibilities now
2 vested in the state board of charities and corrections by sec-
3 tion fifty-eight of chapter sixty-four, as amended by chapter
4 one hundred seventy-six of the public laws of nineteen hun-
5 dred and seventeen, with reference to the licensing of ma-
6 ternity hospitals, as defined in section four of chapter one
7 hundred and forty-nine, public laws of nineteen hundred and
8 seventeen, are hereby transferred to and vested in the state
9 department of health.

Sect. 2. Any licenses issued by the state board of charities
2 and corrections and remaining in force at the time that

3 this act takes effect shall continue in force until the expira-
4 tion of the period for which they were granted, unless sooner
5 revoked by the commissioner of health for cause.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith
2 are hereby repealed.
