## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT Governing the Conduct of Maternity Hospitals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. The powers, duties and responsibilities now
vested in the state board of charities and corrections by section fifty-eight of chapter sixty-four, as amended by chapter
one hundred seventy-six of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, with reference to the licensing of maternity hospitals, as defined in section four of chapter one
hundred and forty-nine, public laws of nineteen hundred and
seventeen, are hereby transferred to and vested in the state
department of health.

Sect. 2. Any licenses issued by the state board of charities 2 and corrections and remaining in force at the time that

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3 this act takes effect shall continue in force until the expira-4 tion of the period for which they were granted, unless sooner5 revoked by the commissioner of health for cause.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith 2 are hereby repealed.
