**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Amend Section Ten of Chapter Forty-six of the
Revised Statutes as Amended by Chapter Seventy-four of
the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Nineteen Relating to
the Weight and Sale of Coal.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section ten of chapter forty-six of the revised statutes as
2 amended by chapter seventy-four of the public laws of nine-
3 teen hundred nineteen is hereby further amended by insert-
4 ing between the words "coal" and "shall" in the second line
5 of said section, the words 'or coke'; and also by inserting
6 between the words "coal" and "put" in the third line of said

7 section, the words 'or coke'; so that said section as amended
8 shall read as follows :

'Sect. 10. Anthracite, bituminous and all mineral coal or
2 coke shall be sold by weight and two thousand pounds shall
3 constitute a ton. Coal or coke put up in bags or package
4 form shall have marked on the bag in a plain and conspicu-
5 ous manner the net weight. For each violation of this act
6 a fine of not less than twenty-five nor more than one hun-
7 dred dollars shall be imposed.'
