AN ACT to Amend Section Eighty-two of Chapter Sixteen of  
the Revised Statutes Relating to Free High Schools.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eighty-two of chapter sixteen of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting in the tenth line thereof, after the word "superintending," the word 'school', so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Free high schools, established and maintained under the foregoing provisions, are subject to the laws relating to common schools, so far as applicable, except as otherwise provided. When established and maintained by a town, they shall be under the supervision and entire management of the superintending school committee of such town. When established and maintained by a union of towns, such school

8 shall be under the supervision and entire management of  
9 the school committees of such towns, who constitute a joint  
10 board for that purpose. When established and maintained  
11 by any precinct, such school shall be under the supervision  
12 of the superintending school committee of such town, or of  
13 the state superintendent, when the precinct so elects, and  
14 under the financial management of the agent of the pre-  
15 cinct, who, in connection with said committee or superin-  
16 tendent, shall employ teachers for the same. When estab-  
17 lished and maintained by precincts composed of sections of  
18 adjoining towns, such school shall be under the supervision  
19 of the superintending school committees of such towns, who  
20 constitute a joint board for that purpose, and under the  
21 financial management of the agents of both precincts, who  
22 in connection with said committees, shall employ the teach-  
23 ers.'
