STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Amend so much of the Paragraph of Chapter
Eighty-two, Section Fifty-one of the Revised Statutes as Re-
lates to the Holding of Trial Terms of the Supreme Judi-
cial Court for the County of Sagadahoc.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of the paragraph of chapter eighty-two, section
2 fifty-one of the revised statutes as relates to the holding of
3 trial terms of the supreme judicial court for the county of
4 Sagadahoc is hereby amended by striking out all of said
5 paragraph and substituting in place thereof the following:

‘Section 1. “Sagadahoc, at Bath, on the fourth Tuesday of
2 January, the second Tuesday of May and the third Tuesday
3 of October.”

Sect. 2. All matters or proceedings commenced before or
2 after this act takes effect and returnable to, and all matters
3 pending in said court, and which would, but for the provi-
4 sions of this act, be entered and have day at the term of
5 said court to be held on the second Tuesday of October in
6 the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twen-
7 ty-one, as provided by law, shall be entered and have day at
8 the term of the supreme judicial court in said county to be
9 held on the third Tuesday of October in the year of our
10 Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one which is
11 substituted by this act for said second Tuesday of October,
12 and shall have day therein as if originally made returnable
13 to said third Tuesday of October.’
