STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

RESOLVE in favor of Cary Hospital, Caribou, Aroostook County, to aid in the construction of a hospital.

Resolved: That there be paid to the managers of said Cary
2 Hospital, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), to aid
3 in the erection of a hospital in Caribou, provided the town
4 of Caribou shall raise and deposit with the treasurer of
5 State, the sum of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000). The
6 above sum of ten thousand dollars is to be available on or
7 before the thirtieth day of June, 1922, when the said forty
8 thousand dollars (\$40,000) shall have been raised and de-
9 posited with the treasurer of State.
