### STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT regulating the sale of liquor in Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The regulation governing the keeping and sale of in-2 toxicating liquors in this state shall be the same as the 5 regulations which now are in force, or shall hereafter be 4 adopted by the Congress of the United States for the en-5 forcement of the eighteenth amendment of the Constitu-6 tion of the United States.
