STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT regulating the sale of liquor in Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The regulation governing the keeping and sale of intoxicating liquors in this state shall be the same as the regulations which now are in force, or shall hereafter be adopted by the Congress of the United States for the enforcement of the eighteenth amendment of the Constitution of the United States.
