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Resolved: That there shall be paid to Henry E. Dunnack  
2 for his services in preparing and editing The Maine Book  
3 the sum of five hundred dollars and for this purpose five  
4 hundred dollars is hereby appropriated. The same is to be  
5 paid from receipts of The Maine Book already sold.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Maine Book was prepared at the request of the Governor and Council as a centennial research book about Maine. Nearly three thousand copies have been sold and the money turned into the state treasury. The author received no compensation for his work.
