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**STATE OF MAINE**

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

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AN ACT Additional to Chapter Thirty-three of the Revised Statutes, as Amended, Prohibiting Fishing in the Tributaries to Lake Annabessacook, in the County of Kennebec.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person at any  
2 time to fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish in any  
3 of the tributaries to Lake Annabessacook, which lake is sit-  
4 uated in the town of Winthrop and in the town of Mon-  
5 outh, in the county of Kennebec. It shall also be un-  
6 lawful for any person to have in possession at any time  
7 any kind of fish taken in violation of any provision of this  
8 act.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall  
2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten nor more than  
3 thirty dollars and costs for each offense, and one dollar  
4 additional for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in pos-  
5 session in violation of any provision of this act.
