**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Amend Section Eighty-five of Chapter Eighty-
two of the Revised Statutes Relating to the Terms of Supe-
rior Court for the County of Kennebec.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eighty-five of chapter eighty-two of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words "sec-
3 ond Tuesdays of June and November" in the third line of
4 said section and inserting in place thereof the words 'fourth
5 Tuesday of May and the second Tuesday of November,'
6 so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sec. 85. Said court shall be held at Augusta on the sec-
2 ond Tuesday of January, and the first Tuesdays of April
3 and September, and at Waterville on the fourth Tuesday

4 of May and the second Tuesday of November; but the
5 criminal business of said county shall be transacted at the
6 terms held on the second Tuesday of January and the first
7 Tuesdays of April and September, together with civil bus-
8 iness. The judge of said court may continue any case pend-
9 ing in said court without costs, when in his judgment jus-
10 tice may require it, in order to give the parties in interest
11 opportunity to try any such case in either Waterville or Au-
12 gusta in said county.
