STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Section Eighty-five of Chapter Eightytwo of the Revised Statutes Relating to the Terms of Superior Court for the County of Kennebee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section eighty-five of chapter eighty-two of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words "sec3 ond Tuesdays of June and November" in the third line of
4 said section and inserting in place thereof the words 'fourth
5 Tuesday of May and the second Tuesday of November,'
6 so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sec. 85. Said court shall be held at Augusta on the sec-2 ond Tuesday of January, and the first Tuesdays of April 3 and September, and at Waterville on the fourth Tuesday

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4 of May and the second Tuesday of November; but the 5 criminal business of said county shall be transacted at the 6 terms held on the second Tuesday of January and the first 7 Tuesdays of April and September, together with civil bus-8 iness. The judge of said court may continue any case pend-9 ing in said court without costs, when in his judgment jus-10 tice may require it, in order to give the parties in interest 11 opportunity to try any such case in either Waterville or Au-12 gusta in said county
