STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Control the Establishment of Sanatoriums and Hospitals for Infectious and Contagious Diseases Within the Populous Districts of Cities and Towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. No persons, firm or corporation shall establish
2 or maintain within the populous districts of any city or
3 town in this state, any sanatorium or hospital designed for
4 the treatment of persons suffering from tuberculosis or oth5 er infectious or contagious disease unless approval has been
6 obtained from the municipal officers of the city or town in
7 question and from the state department of health.

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Sect. 2. Any persons, firm or corporation found guilty of 2 violating the provisions of section one of this act shall be 3 punished by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars 4 or imprisonment not exceeding one year and jurisdiction in 5 equity to enjoin threatened violations of this act is hereby 6 conferred upon the supreme judicial court.
