**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT Authorizing the Town of Bar Harbor to Lay Out
and Maintain Paths Within its Limits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Said town of Bar Harbor is hereby authorized and em-
2 powered to lay out, construct and maintain paths and ways
3 through forests, fields and other suitable places within its
4 limits to be designated paths to be used, except when the
5 ground is frozen solid, only for horse back riding and by
6 pedestrians.

All procedure shall be the same as is now provided by law
2 in the case of town ways.
