RESOLVE, in Favor of Bert Allard of Richmond for Damages Caused by Highway Work.

Resolved: That the sum of one hundred dollars (100.00) be and hereby is appropriated, to be paid to Bert Allard of Richmond, on account of his claim against the State of Maine, for loss of rental of property in Richmond to said state in nineteen hundred and nineteen. Also for damages to his driveway along the state road in said town, in nineteen hundred and nineteen and damages on account of stone taken out of the state road and piled in the ditch by the men employed on state road, in said town, in nineteen hundred and nineteen.
