# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Bert Allard of Richmond for Damages Caused by Highway Work.

Resolved: That the sum of one hundred dollars (100.00) 2 be and hereby is appropriated, to be paid to Bert Allard of 3 Richmond, on account of his claim against the State of 4 Maine, for loss of rental of property in Richmond to said 5 state in nineteen hundred and nineteen. Also for damages 6 to his driveway along the state road in said town, in nine-7 teen hundred and nineteen and damages on account of stone 8 taken out of the state road and piled in the ditch by the 9 men employed on state road, in said town, in nineteen hun-10 dred and nineteen.
