STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT Relating to the Wrapping of Bread.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person, firm or corporation shall distribute,
2 transport, or sell for distribution or transportation any
3 bread, in loaf form, which is not properly enclosed in a san-
4 itary wrapper.

Sect. 2. Any person, firm or corporation who violates any
2 provision of this act shall be punished by a fine of not more
3 than one hundred dollars for the first offense and by a fine
4 of not more than two hundred dollars for each subsequent
5 offense.

Sect. 3. Municipal and police courts and trial justices
2 shall have jurisdiction of the above offenses.
