STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Require a Fee for Registration of Milk Dealers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Each milk dealer when applying for registration as pro-2 vided for by section five, chapter thirty-seven of the re-3 vised statutes, and amendments thereto, shall pay to the 4 commissioner of agriculture a fee of one dollar for each 5 milk depot, vehicle and place from which sales are made.
6 All money received by the commissioner of agriculture un-7 der this section shall be paid by him to the treasurer of 8 the state, and the same is hereby appropriated for the pur-9 poses specified in chapter thirty-seven, and sections two, 10 three, six, seven, eight, nine, ten, eleven and twelve of chap-11 ter one hundred thirty of revised statutes.
