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**STATE OF MAINE**

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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

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AN ACT to Provide Additional Funds for the Maintenance of  
State and State Aid Highways.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

A tax of one-third of a mill on a dollar shall be annually  
2 assessed upon all property of the state according to the  
3 value thereof, to be known as the mill tax state highway  
4 maintenance fund. The proceeds of said fund shall be  
5 used exclusively for the maintenance of highways as pro-  
6 vided in sections eight, seventeen, twenty-five, twenty-six,  
7 twenty-seven and twenty-eight of chapter twenty-five of the  
8 revised statutes as amended. If any unexpended balance  
9 of said mill tax maintenance fund hereby created remains

10 at the end of any fiscal year, said balance shall be carried  
11 forward and credited to the same account at the beginning  
12 of the next year and used for said purposes of maintenance.
