RESOLVE, in Favor of the Western Maine Sanatorium.

Whereas, no regular appropriation is available until ninety days after the adjournment of the legislature making the same, and

Whereas, funds are necessary for personal services at and maintenance of the Western Maine Sanatorium, or the said, sanatorium will have to be closed, and

Whereas, the need for the maintenance of said sanatorium is an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore,

Resolved: Section 1. That there be and there hereby is 2 appropriated for the Western Maine Sanatorium for per-
