**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Amend Section Two of Chapter One Hundred
Eleven of the Revised Statutes Relating to Selection and
Services of Jurors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Amend section two of chapter one hundred and eleven of
2 the revised statutes by inserting after the word "of" and
3 before the word "persons" the words 'male and female,'
4 so that said section when amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Such board, at least once in every three years,
2 shall prepare a list of male and female persons, under the
3 age of seventy years, qualified to serve as jurors; and in
4 preparing such list they shall take the names of such persons

5 only as are of good moral character, of approved integrity,
6 of sound judgment and well informed, and qualified as the
7 constitution directs to vote for representatives in such town.
8 When a new list is made, the municipal officers shall transfer
9 from the old to the new tickets of the same persons, the
10 minutes of the draft made within the three preceding years.'
