STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Increase the Military Fund, Amending Section
Ninety-one, of Chapter Two Hundred Fifty-nine, of the
Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section ninety-one, of chapter two hundred and fifty-
2 nine of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen,
3 is hereby amended by striking out in the first and second
4 lines thereof the words "the purpose of raising revenue to
5 defray"; also by striking out in the third and fourth lines
6 of said section the words "from any money in the treasury
7 not otherwise appropriated"; also by striking out in the

8 fourth line the words "forty-five thousand" and inserting
9 in the place thereof the words 'ninety-five thousand'; also
10 by striking out in the fifth line thereof the words "at least
11 five thousand dollars or so," and inserting in place thereof
12 the word 'as'; also by striking out in the seventh and eighth
13 lines the words "the revenue thus raised shall be paid into
14 the state treasury and be converted into a special and," and
15 inserting in place thereof the words "The appropriation thus
16 provided shall constitute a"; so that as amended said sec-
17 tion shall read as follows:

'Sect. 91. The military fund. For the current expenses
2 of the national guard and naval militia there shall be ap-
3 propriated annually the sum of ninety-five thousand dollars,
4 of which sum as much thereof as may be necessary shall
5 be appropriated by the paymaster general for the support
6 of the naval militia. The appropriation thus provided shall
7 constitute a continuous military fund, from which special
8 fund only, except where herein otherwise specified, shall
9 be paid the expenses authorized by this act; and so much
10 thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated to carry
11 out the provisions of this section, to be paid upon vouchers
12 approved as provided in section ninety.'
