STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

RESOLVE, in Favor of Several Academies, Institutes, Seminaries and Colleges for Maintenance, Repairs and Improvements.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in
2 favor of the several academies, institutes, seminaries and
3 colleges hereinafter listed the sum of thirty-one thousand
4 nine hundred dollars for the period from January first,
5 nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June thirtieth, nine-
6 teen hundred and twenty-one; the sum of fifty-six thousand
7 six hundred and seventy-five dollars for the period from
8 July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June thir-
9 tieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, and the sum of

10 fifty-six thousand two hundred and fifty dollars for the
 11 period from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-two,
 12 to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-three, said
 13 sums to be expended under the direction of the board of
 14 trustees of said institutions to the amount and for the pur-
 15 poses indicated in the following schedule:
