STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Two Hundred Thirty-nine of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Nineteen, Relating to the Use for Public Purposes of Armories Built by Municipalities with State Aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter two hundred thirty-nine of the public laws of 2 nineteen hundred nineteen is hereby amended by adding 3 thereto the following section:

'Sect. 3. All armories erected under this act shall be sub-2 ject to the provisions of section ninety-eight of chapter two 3 hundred fifty-nine of the public laws of nineteen hundred 4 seventeen; but nothing therein contained shall be construed 5 to prevent the use of any armory erected under this act for 6 such other public purposes, not interfering with its use for 7 military purposes, as the municipal officers may authorize.

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
