STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, for Extra Pay to the Maine Volunteers, War with Spain.

Resolved: That the sum of twenty-two dollars for the 2 six months ending June thirty, nineteen hundred and twenty-3 one, sixty-six dollars for the fiscal year of nineteen hun-4 dred and twenty-two, and sixty-six dollars for the fiscal year 5 of nineteen hundred and twenty-three, be and are hereby 6 appropriated for payment of outstanding claims for extra 7 pay for the Maine volunteers in the war with Spain.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Men who enlisted in the Maine organizations for the Spanish War were paid by the state two months extra pay, which in case of a private amounted to twenty-two dollars. A few claims are still unpaid. This appropriation will take care of three each year.
