STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Bath Military and Naval Orphan Asylum.

Whereas, the fiscal year of the State of Maine now ends on June thirtieth instead of January first, and no money is available under a regular appropriation for the first six months of the year nineteen hundred and twenty-one, and whereas the appropriation for the first six months in nineteen hundred and twenty-one for the Bath Military and Naval Orphan Asylum is an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore

Resolved: That there be paid to the Bath Military and

2 Naval Orphan Asylum for maintenance, nine thousand hundred seventy-five dollars (\$9,275)4 period from January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-5 one, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-one; 6 eighteen thousand five hundred fifty dollars (\$18,550) for 7 the year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, 8 to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two; eigh-9 teen thousand five hundred fifty dollars (\$18,550) for the 10 year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, to II June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-three. That 12 there be paid for personal services in the aforenamed in-13 stitution, three thousand one hundred dollars (\$3,100) for 14 the period from January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-15 one, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-one; 16 six thousand two hundred dollars (\$6,200) for the year 17 from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June 18 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two; six thousand 19 two hundred dollars (\$6,200) for the year from July first, 20 nineteen hundred and twenty-two, to June thirtieth, nine-21 teen hundred and twenty-three.

In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this re-2 solve shall take effect when approved.

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
