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**STATE OF MAINE**

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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

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RESOLVE, in Favor of the Central Maine Sanatorium,  
Fairfield, Somerset County.

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Whereas, the change in the fiscal year, made by statute in  
nineteen hundred and nineteen, leaves the six months from  
January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one to June thir-  
tieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, a period for which an  
appropriation to be available, must be made as an emergency,  
and, whereas the appropriation of money for the said six  
months is an emergency measure and is necessary for the pub-  
lic peace, health and safety, now, therefore,

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for  
2 the Central Maine Sanatorium:

For personal services, namely, for salaries and wages of  
2 all officers and employees except those wholly engaged in  
3 repairs of buildings and equipment, the sum of twenty  
4 thousand dollars for the period from January first, nine-  
5 teen hundred and twenty-one, to June thirtieth, nineteen  
6 hundred and twenty-one; the sum of forty thousand dollars  
7 from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June  
8 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two; and the sum  
9 of forty thousand dollars from July first, nineteen hundred  
10 and twenty-two, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and  
11 twenty-three.

For maintenance, namely, all articles of food and all other  
2 materials, supplies and expenses incident to maintenance of  
3 the institution and the patients thereof, whether present or  
4 absent, the sum of fifty-four thousand twenty-seven dollars  
5 and twenty cents for the period from January first, nine-  
6 teen hundred and twenty-one, to June thirtieth, nineteen  
7 hundred and twenty-one; the sum of one hundred nine  
8 thousand fifty-four dollars and forty cents for the period  
9 from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June  
10 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two; and the sum  
11 of one hundred nine thousand fifty-four dollars and forty  
12 cents for the period from July first, nineteen hundred and  
13 twenty-two, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-  
14 three.

In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this re-  
2 solve shall take effect when approved.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Central Maine Sanatorium has been established in Fairfield, Somerset County, for a number of years where it has been receiving and cared for patients affected by tuberculosis. There are at present upon the location three large buildings providing quarters for about one hundred patients, nurses, etc. Since the opening of this institution it has been filled with patients and splendid work has been done. The amounts asked for in this resolve were suggested by the Board of Trustees as being necessary for carrying on work in an efficient manner, and are the same amounts as recommended by the Budget Committee.
