RESOLVE, in Favor of Wallace Lewey, Representative of the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians.

Resolved: That there be appropriated and paid to Wal-2 lace Lewey, representative of the Passamaquoddy tribe of 3 Indians at the eightieth session of the legislature, one hun-4 dred sixty-five dollars (\$165) for attendance and forty-two 5 dollars (\$42) for mileage.
