STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide for the Appointment of a Treasurer and Resident Auditor at the University of Maine, and Define Their Duties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. The trustees of the University of Maine shall
2 appoint a full time treasurer, who shall give bond for the
3 faithful performance of his duties in such amount and with
4 such conditions and sureties, and shall receive such com5 pensation as the governor and council may determine.

Sect. 2. The treasurer shall have full charge of the pur-2 chase of all supplies, material and equipment for the use

3 of the university, receipts of all moneys, and of all ex-4 penditures, said payments to be made when certified by 5 the state auditor, and said treasurer shall have no author-6 ity to contracts debts or obligations in excess of said ap-7 propriation, nor under any conditions use moneys so appro-8 priated for the benefit of any other college or colleges, 9 unless the same is duly and properly authorized by the 10 governor and council.

Sect. 3. The treasurer shall prepare a complete report 2 for the periods ending on June thirtieth and December 3 thirty-first of each year, and forward a copy of said semi-4 annual report of the colleges to the governor and council 5 and also the board of trustees.

Sect. 4. The state auditor shall appoint a resident auditor 2 for the University of Maine, whose duties shall be to audit 3 the accounts, and perform such other work as may be 4 required of him, under direction and by the state auditor, 5 suitable office quarters to be furnished by the university. 6 The salary and just expenses of the resident auditor to be 7 paid from the state auditor's appropriations.

Sect. 5. Section one of this act shall take effect, July first, 2 nineteen hundred and twenty-two.
