## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Maine General Hospital.

Whereas, the fiscal year of the State of Maine now ends on June thirtieth instead of January first, and no money is available under a regular appropriation for the first six months of the year nineteen hundred and twenty-one, and whereas, the appropriation for the first six months of the year nineteen hundred and twenty-one for the Maine General Hospital is an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore

Resolved: That there be appropriated for grading the 2 grounds of the Maine General Hospital for the period from 3 January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June

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4 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, the sum of five 5 hundred dollars, and for the period from July first, nine-6 teen hundred and twenty-one, to June thirtieth, nineteen 7 hundred and twenty-two, the sum of five hundred dollars. 8 The above amounts are to be expended under direction of 9 George F. Kavanough, Arthur F. Moulton and Fred J. Har-10 rigan, all of Portland.

In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this re-2 solve shall take effect when approved.
