STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Bangor State Hospital for Maintenance During the Years Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one,
Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-two and Nineteen Hundred
and Twenty-three.

Whereas, the institution hereinafter referred to cannot be properly and adequately maintained for the period ending June 30, 1921, without assistance from the State, and whereas the proper maintenance of said institution is urgently necessary in the interest of the public peace, health and safety, and in the

judgment of this legislature an emergency exists within the meaning of the constitution of this State:

Now therefore resolved: That there be, and hereby is ap-2 propriated for the Bangor State Hospital:

For personal services, namely, for salaries and wages for all officers and employees, for two years and one-half, January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one to June thirtieth nineteen hundred and twenty-one, the sum of fifty-six thousand, two hundred and fifty dollars; July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, the sum of one hundred twelve thousand, five hundred dollars; July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-two to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-three, the sum of one hundred and twelve thousand, five hundred dollars.

Maintenance, namely, all articles of food, all articles of personal clothing and materials for making the same, all materials and supplies required for upkeep of grounds, buildings and attached fixtures, all additions to and repairs and replacements of furniture and equipment, including farm equipment and livestock, and for general expenses; January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, the sum of eighty-two thousand, eight hundred and forty dollars; July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, the sum of one hundred and sixty-five thousand, six huntwo, the sum of one hundred and sixty-five thousand, six hun-

Provided, that any balance of the sums above appropriated 2 for the period January first to June thirtieth, nineteen hun3 dred and twenty-one, which may remain unexpended at the 4 end of the six months, shall be available for expenditures 5 during the year following, and that any balance of the sums 6 above appropriated for the year, July first, nineteen hundred 7 and twenty-one to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and 8 twenty-two, which may remain unexpended at the end of the 9 year, shall be available for expenditures during the year following, and provided further, that the Governor and Council

11 may, by order, upon recommendation of the trustees of the 12 said institution, authorize the use of any unexpended balance 13 in any of the items contained in the above appropriation, to 14 apply toward any deficiency that may exist in any other.

In view of the emergency cited above, this resolve shall at taken effect when approved.
