STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Amend Sections Four and Six of Chapter Two
Hundred and Sixty-two of the Public Laws of Nineteen
Hundred and Seventeen, Relating to Fees of City Clerks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section four of chapter two hundred sixty-
2 two of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen
3 is hereby amended by striking out the words "with the
4 fee for the same" in the fourth line thereof and by adding
5 at the end of said section the following words: 'The city
6 clerk shall pay the examiner the sum of one dollar and
7 seventy-five cents out of the fee of two dollars deposited
8 with him for that purpose, retaining the sum of twenty-five

9 cents as payment for the attested copy issued by said city
10 clerk,' so that said section when amended shall read as fol-
11 lows:

'Sect. 4. An examiner's fee of two dollars for every ap-
2 plicant shall be paid to the city clerk when application is
3 made. It shall be the duty of the city clerk to forward all
4 applications to the examiner. The examiner shall examine
5 all applicants in writing, and shall issue a certificate in
6 the following form, if the applicant is of temperate habits
7 and has suitable competency:

'STATE OF MAINE

'This is to certify that _____ having made appli-
2 cation to the city clerk for permission to take charge of
3 and to operate a steam plant, and having produced evidence
4 of his competency to act in said capacity as
5 I have issued to him this certificate as approved by law
6 this _____ day of

'Said certificate when issued shall be filed in the office of
2 the city clerk and said clerk shall issue and deliver to said
3 applicant a duly attested copy of said certificate; and the
4 copy so issued shall be posted by the holder thereof in a
5 frame under glass in a conspicuous place in or near the
6 boiler room of the steam plant to be operated. The city
7 clerk shall pay the examiner the sum of one dollar and
8 seventy-five cents out of the fee of two dollars deposited
9 with him for that purpose, retaining the sum of twenty-
10 five cents as payment for the attested copy issued by said
11 city clerk.'

Sect. 2. Section six of chapter two hundred sixty-two of
2 the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen is here-
3 by amended by adding at the end thereof the following
4 words: 'upon payment of the usual fee of twenty-five cents,'
5 so that the section when amended shall read as follows:

'Sec. 6. When an engineer or fireman shall apply for a
2 renewal of his license for the same grade, the presentation
3 of the attested copy of the original certificate shall be con-
4 sidered sufficient evidence of his title to renewal, which
5 certificate shall be retained by the examiner upon the offi-
6 cial files as the evidence upon which the license was re-
7 newed, and a new certificate shall be issued upon the pay-
8 ment of the fee of one dollar, twenty-five cents of which
9 shall be paid to the city clerk for issuing said new certifi-
10 cate, unless such license shall be forfeited or unless facts
11 shall have come to the knowledge of the examiner which
12 would render a renewal improper. In such case the appli-
13 cant shall be entitled to a hearing before the examiner.
14 In case of loss or destruction of applicant's certified copy
15 of his license, the city clerk shall by direction of the ex-
16 aminer, issue to the applicant a duplicate attested copy,
17 upon payment of the usual fee of twenty-five cents.'
