STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, to Provide for the Re-codification of the State

Constitution.

Resolved: That after the amendments to the constitu2 tion of this state proposed at this session of the legislature
3 shall have been submitted to popular vote, the chief jus4 tice of the supreme judicial court shall arrange the consti5 tution, as amended, under appropriate titles, and in proper
6 articles, parts and sections, omitting all sections, clauses
7 and words not in force, and making no other changes in
8 the provisions or language thereof, and shall submit the
9 same to the legislature at its next regular session. And
10 the draft and arrangement, when approved by the legisla-

11 ture, shall be enrolled on parchment and deposited in the 12 office of the secretary of state; and printed copies thereof 13 shall be prefixed to the books containing the laws of the 14 state. And the constitution, with the amendments made 15 thereto, in accordance with the provisions thereof, shall be 16 the supreme law of the state.
