STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Authorize Counties, Cities and Towns, and Municipal Public Service Corporations, to Pension Employees After Long and Honorable Service.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Any county, city, town, or subdivision thereof, or any municipal public service corporation, is hereby authorized to place upon a pension roll any official or employee who has faithfully served such county, city, town or corporation for the term of not less than twenty-five consecutive years immediately prior to the time of his retirement; such pension not to exceed one-half the annual wage or salary received by him for the year immediately previous thereto.
