STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Better Protect the Lobster Industry within Two Miles from the Shore of Monhegan Island between the First Day of June and the Twenty-fifth Day of November of Each Year.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as tollows:

Section I. Chapter sixty-one, section one of the private 2 and special laws of nineteen hundred and seven, is hereby 3 amended by striking out all of said section and inserting 4 in place thereof the following: 'It shall be unlawful to 5 take, catch, kill, destroy by trap or other device any lobster 6 or lobsters within two miles of the shore of Monhegan

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7 island between the first day of June and the twenty-fifth 8 of November of each and every year except that lobsters 9 may be caught between the twenty-fifth day of June and 10 fifteenth day of September for immediate consumption on 11 the island but not for sale.'

'Section 1. It shall be unlawful to take, catch, kill, destroy 2 by trap or other device any lobster or lobsters within two 3 miles of the shore of Monhegan island between the first day 4 of June and the twenty-fifth of November of each and every 5 year except that lobsters may be caught between the twenty-6 fifth day of June and fifteenth day of September for im-7 mediate consumption on the island but not for sale.'

Sect. 2. Chapter two hundred and ten of the private and 2 special laws of nineteen hundred and nine is hereby repealed.

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
