STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of P. F. Crane, Secretary of the Senate
of the Seventy-ninth Legislature.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of one hundred dollars for services, and fifteen dollars
3 for mileage to be paid P. F. Crane, of Bangor, for services
4 rendered in preparing for and organizing the Senate of the
5 Eightieth Legislature, as required by statutes; and for serv-
6 ices rendered the president and secretary of the Senate
7 during the first week of the regular session of the Senate
8 of said legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

P. F. Crane was secretary of the Senate of the Seventy-ninth Legislature and in accordance with the statutes of the State of Maine prepared and organized the Senate of the Eightieth Legislature; subsequently assisting the president and secretary of the Senate during the first week of the session. The sum stated was approved by the president of the Senate. P. F. Crane resides in Bangor, Maine, seventy-five miles from Augusta.
