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**STATE OF MAINE**

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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

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RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Expenses of the Electoral College for the State of Maine for the Year Nineteen Hundred Twenty-one.

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Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the  
2 sum of four hundred and fifty-one dollars to defray the  
3 expenses of the Electoral College for the State of Maine,  
4 which convened at Augusta the eighth day of January, nine-  
5 teen hundred and twenty-one.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Electoral College for the State of Maine convened at Augusta, January 8th, 1921, according to the statutes. The electors passed an order covering the expenses of the session of the Electoral College, amounting in the aggregate to \$451, which was duly signed by the president and the secretary, as required, and submitted to the state auditor for payment. As no appropriation exists for this account the foregoing Resolve is required, and is the usual procedure.
